ESG investing is one of the fastest growing areas in recent years and has shifted from a niche area of investment into the mainstream. While it is encouraging to see certain rules and initiatives in place to promote ESG reporting and integration, a strategy combining incentives and regulations needs to be developed to support the sustained development of the industry.
